

# Tent Capacity Information

For a 20' x 30' tent, you have approximately 600 square feet of available space.

Below are estimates on the number of people you may fit under a 20' x 30' tent in certain situations.

Stand Up / Cocktail Party ~ 120 people

Buffet Dinner ~ 85 people

Sit Down w/ Long Tables ~ 60 people

\*This does not allow for aisles, dance floors, service areas, etc.

## Guidelines for Tent Seating Charts

- For standing or cathedral seating, you need to figure 5-6 sq. ft. per person.
- If all guests are going to be seated, you will want 10-12 sq. ft. per person
  - ◇ For a buffet dinner, you need 7-8 sq. ft. per person
  - ◇ For use of long table, you need 8 sq. ft. per person
  - ◇ For a sit down dinner w/ 72" round tables, you need 8-10 sq. ft. per person
  - ◇ If you are using 8ft. Banquet tables, you need 12 sq. ft. per person
- Dance Floors
  - ◇ For a dinner/dance, you need 4 sq. ft. per person
  - ◇ For a wedding, you need to figure on 2-3 sq. ft. per person
    - \* To figure out the size of dance floor, figure on a 3x3 section for 4 people. So, for 100 people, you would need a 15x15 dance floor.
- For a platform for speakers, you will need approximately 10 sq. ft.
- If you are having a band
  - ◇ You need to figure on 20 sq. ft. for the drum set
  - ◇ For a piano, you'll need 30 sq. ft. for a Spinnet & 100 sq. ft. for a Grand Piano
- For the bar area, you will want to average about 30 sq. ft. of space.
